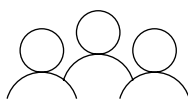

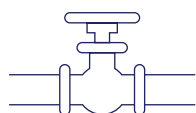
Across approximately 407,000 water and wastewater service connections, we invest in critical infrastructure to protect and strengthen water supply for generations to come.

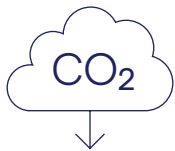

We are also committed environmental stewards—prioritizing water conservation, climate resilience, and the sustainable management of our natural resources.



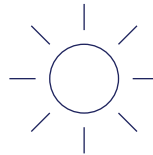
